Aug 3	2 nd Lt. W.J. HOWELL, 3/West Surrey Regt. Attached as Signalling Instructor, proceeded Overseas.
Aug 4	78 Gunners were transferred to 4A Res. Bde. For drafting Overseas The Chaplain General of the Forces ordered special Church Services to be held, it being the second Anniversary of the Declaration of War.
Aug 6	The under mentioned Officers proceeded Overseas Capt. W. SHELDON DICKASON, 3/2 nd London D.A.C. Capt. P. OAKLEY, 3/5 th London Bde. R.F.A.
Aug 10	The following Men were transferred to 57 th Divl. Artillery. 12 Gunners 12 Signallers 12 Artificers
Aug 11	The under mentioned Officers proceeded Overseas Lieut. P.J. COLE 3/5 th Lond. Bde. R.F.A. 2 nd Lt. P.L. HAYCOCK “ Lieut. LUCIE SMITH 3/6 th Lond. Bde. R.F.A. The following Men proceeded Overseas 24 Signallers 2 Artificers
Aug 12	50 Gunners were transferred to 4 “A” Reserve Brigade for drafting overseas
Aug 21	Telegram received from Eastern Command, dated 18 th August 1916, cancelling leave for all ranks as a temporary measure.
Aug 24	Embargo on leave cancelled
Aug 31	The following casualties occurred amongst the Horses during the month of August 1916 215 Joined 187 Transferred 2 Died or Destroyed, leaving a total strength of 469.
