

**MILITARY FUNERAL.**—The funeral took place on Friday at the Church Cemetery of Pte. William Alfred Carter, of 20, Bolton-road, a driver in the Army Service Corps, who was invalided home from France about twelve months ago to hospital at Guildford, and who had been ill ever since, his death occurring on June 4th, at the age of 41. The funeral was attended with military honours, a gun-carriage, with six horses, also a firing party and buglers, being sent from Biscot. The service was conducted by the Rev. A. E.
